DATE: Tuesday, March 9, 2010

TOPIC: Fire Rated Expansion Joints – **Al Shaw**, Fireline 520 LLC and **Jason Frigon**, EMSEAL Joint Systems LTD.

ISSUE: The design and proper installation of expansion joints to maintain integrity of fire separations while also resisting water and building movements. Complex building examples including hospitals, stadiums, shopping malls and parking garages will be discussed. Our speakers will introduce innovative factory-made directional change and transitional joints including elbows, tees and t-joint configurations. Performance requirements and test standards will be reviewed.

Al Shaw has over 40 years of experience in the design, innovation, manufacture and installation of industrial insulation and fire stopping materials. Focusing on the most difficult and challenging requirements, Al has designed, supplied and installed fire barrier systems in commercial, industrial, military and power generation facilities across North America.
