TOPIC: INSULATED WALL PANELS

On May 7, 2009 a violent fire completely destroyed the Viandes Paquette food processing plant in Henryville, Quebec. That fire provides a backdrop to this presentation on why Insulated Wall Panels, particularly those with foamed plastic cores, invoke specific fire test requirements and limitations in order to comply with the NBCC. Our speaker will outline the applicable Building Code fire and life safety requirements associated with the use of Insulated Wall Panels for exterior wall applications, interior partitions and suspended ceilings in buildings.
