TOPIC: Fire Protection System Commissioning &
the new CAN/ULC-S1001-11 Standard

SUMMARY: With the inclusion of “commissioning” of integrated fire protection and life safety systems in the 2010 National Building and Fire Codes of Canada, the ULC Standards Organization aimed to develop a standardized process for this testing. The presentation will provide an overview of current commissioning requirements in Canada, the differences between the integrated testing and commissioning processes, past and current projects being worked on by the ULC Subcommittee on Commissioning, and a discussion on other commissioning standards. The CAN/ULC-S1001-11 Standard will also be reviewed in detail, including the integrated testing process, persons involved, testing requirements, documentation, and life cycle testing in new and existing buildings.
